SPELLING - Students spell correctly, because what is heard correctly is spelled correctly. Plus, there is no rote learning of phonetic words!

SPEECH - The training provided by the Phonovisual Method automatically corrects many defective speech sounds. Learners develop a keen ear for detecting even slight variations in syllables, vowel sounds, and word endings, enabling them to reproduce the sounds correctly.


